# In Remembrance

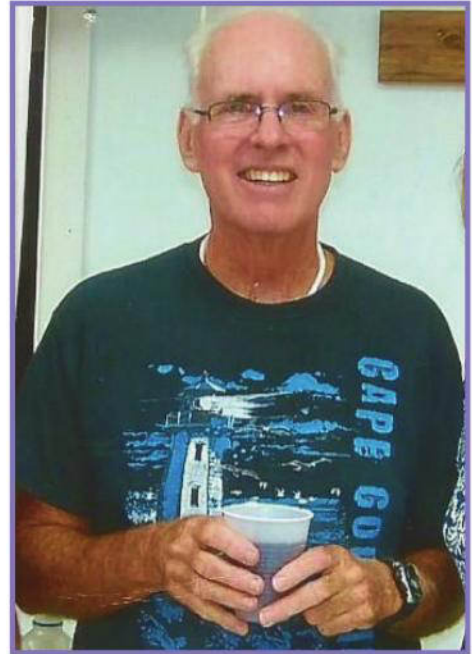
*March 17th marks three years since the passing of Father John Brundage.*

After retiring from Corpus Christi Parish in South River NJ, Father John served San Pablo Parish from June 2013 to his death in 2019. Known as an avid sailor and very fond of sea life, Father John lived on his boat dubbed “The Euphoric” during his time here. All can recall his lively spirit and respect for all God’s Creations, big and small.
