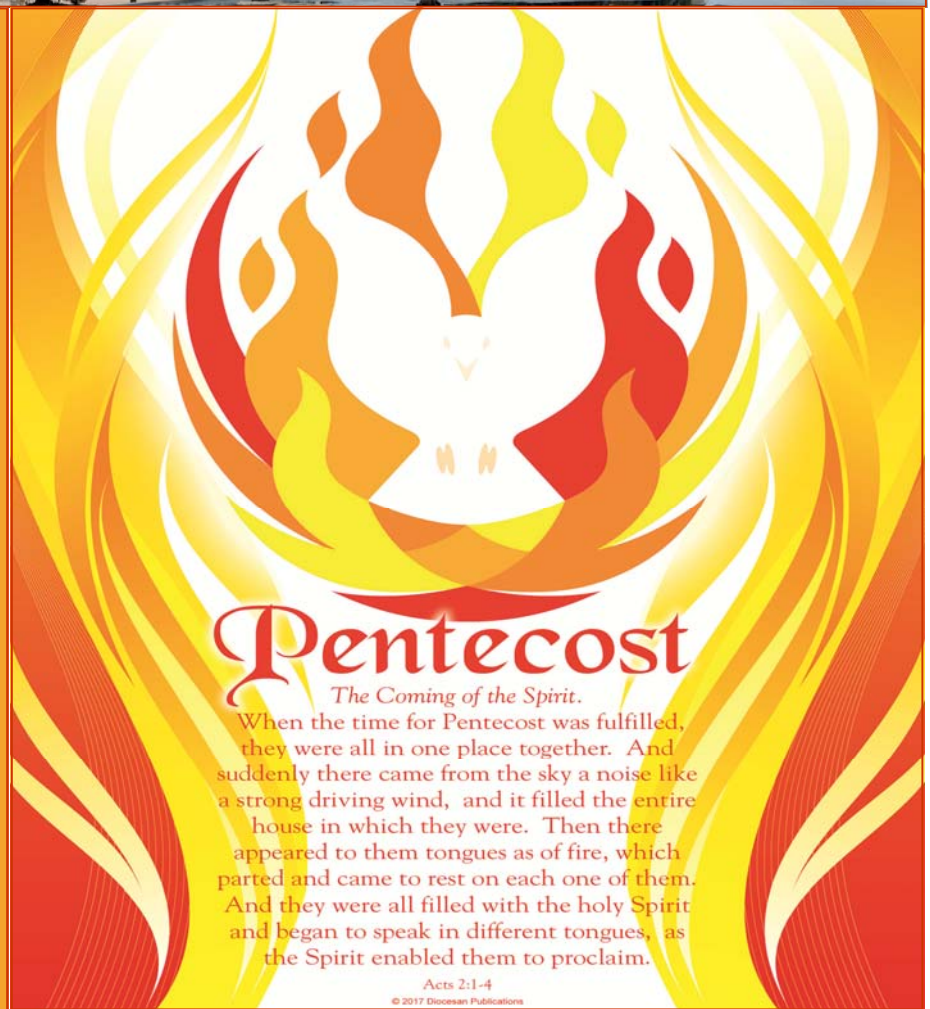

*The Scripture readings over the last several weeks are intended to prepare us for the coming of the Holy Spirit on Pentecost which we celebrate today. Our Bible describes the Holy Spirit as playing a significant role in three major events in the Divine Plan: The Creation of the World, The Birth of Jesus and Pentecost.*

*We may say in a sense, that the Holy Spirit prepared the way for the birth of the world, the birth of Jesus and the birth of our Church. This same Holy Spirit plays a significant role in the birth of every Christian in Baptism, so our Bible portrays the Holy Spirit as being closely connected with the gift of Divine Life, creating the bond of life that unites every Christian to Jesus, to one another, and to the Holy Trinity itself. In the words of the Creed which we profess every time we attend Mass the Spirit is called the "giver of life."*

*These acts of preparation for the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, suggests an intimacy between each of us and our personal loving God-much like that, I suppose of a loving mother for her child in her womb. It is a relationship so profound that one cannot call them two separate people yet, not one person either. They are some mystical number in between.*

*Jesus tells His disciples of His relationship with God and with them, "I am in my Father, and you are in me, and I in you." The disciples will never be apart from Jesus. This permeating, connecting power of the Holy Spirit will keep them forever close. It is the same for each of us. Be open to the Spirit who alone can set you on fire for Christ. Be open to the Spirit! -*
